“If from thence thou shalt seek the LORD thy God, thou shalt find him, if thou seek him with all thy heart and with all thy soul.” (Deut. 4:29)

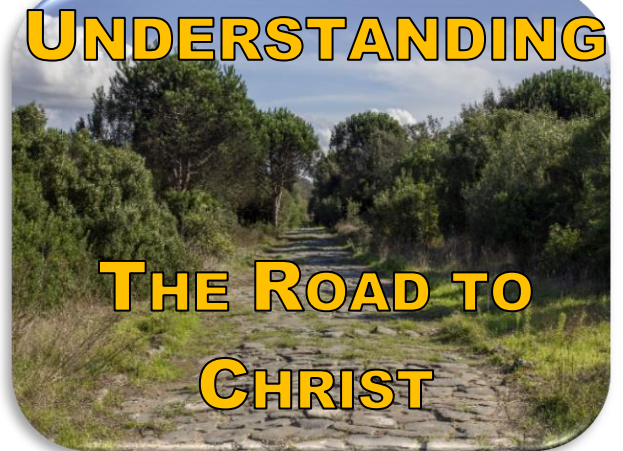
“And ye shall seek me, and find me, when ye shall search for me with all your heart. (Jer. 29:13)
