Hi, I'm Gary Westgerdes, Founder of The Keys of Heaven Ministries. I was born and raised in a Catholic family in a mostly Catholic Community, in Ohio. At age seven a religion class that I was in was being taught about heaven and hell; God was convicting me of my sin and I was worried about going to hell. A week or so later, the class teacher, I don't know why, read John 3:16 and upon hearing God's word I was born again as I trusted in Jesus for the forgiveness of my sins, **"For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life."** After wandering from God my Father this prodigal son sought Him, after coming close to death, and returned home at age 23 for forgiveness. I celebrated my 50th year as a child of God the summer of 2013. My desire for the Bible Believing Ministry is to spread the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Jesus: Matthew 16:19, 21 "And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven ... From that time forth began Jesus to shew ... His disciples, how that He must go unto Jerusalem, and suffer many things of the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised again the third day." Paul: 1 Corinthians 15:1-5, 8 "Brethren, I declare unto you the Gospel which I preached unto you, which also ye have **received**, and wherein ye stand; by which also ye are **saved**, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain. For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures, that He was **buried**, and that He **rose** again the third day according to the scriptures: and that He was seen ..." Peter: Acts 10:36, 39-43 "Preaching peace by Jesus Christ ... whom they slew and hanged on a tree: Him God raised up the third day and shewed Him openly ... even to us, who did eat and drink with Him after He **rose** from the dead. And He commanded us ... to testify that it is He which was ordained of God to be the Judge of quick and dead. To Him give all the prophets witness, that through His name whosoever believeth in Him shall receive remission of sins." Paul: 1 Corinthians 1:17-18, 21, 23, 30, 31 "For Christ sent me not to baptize, but to preach the gospel: not with wisdom of words, lest the cross of Christ should be made of none effect. For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are **saved** it is the power of God ... it pleased God by the foolishness of preaching to save them that believe ... we preach Christ crucified who of God is made unto us wisdom ... righteousness ... sanctification and redemption: He that glorieth, let him glory in the Lord." Paul: Romans 5:1, 17 "Therefore, being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ ... For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ."

JESUS "<u>1.</u> By His Death ... Resurrection, Jesus ... "<u>Opened</u>" Heaven to Us (CCC-1026). SALVATION 2. [The Church] Has Received the Keys of the Kingdom of Heaven ... In her, sins may be forgiven through Christ's blood and the Holy Sprit's action ... the soul dead through sin comes back to life (CCC-981). 3. "Through Christ's CATHOLIC CHURCH ALONE ... the fullness of ... Salvation can be obtained ... The APOSTOLIC **COLLEGE ALONE** ... which Peter is the head ... that Our Lord entrusted all the blessings of the New Covenant ... to establish the One Body of Christ into which all ... should be fully incorporated" (CCC-816). 4. It may be supposed that Such Persons would have desired Baptism explicitly if they had known its necessity (CCC-1260). **PENANCE** 23. If the Church has the Power to Forgive Sins, then Baptism cannot be her only means of using the Keys of the Kingdom of Heaven (CCC-979). 24. The Sacrament of Penance is Necessary for Salvation for Those ... Fallen after Baptism (CCC-980). 26. Individual ... Confession and Absolution remain the Only Ordinary Way for the faithful to Reconcile ... with God and the Church unless physical or moral impossibility (CCC-1484). 27. Only Priest who have received the faculty of absolving from the authority of the Church can forgive sins in the name of Christ (CCC-1495). CONFIRMATION 30. The Sacrament of Confirmation is the full out pouring of the Holy Spirit as once granted to the apostles on the Day of Pentecost (CCC-1302). EUCHARIST / MASS 36. The Sacrifice of Christ and the Sacrifice of the Eucharist are one single Sacrifice: "The Victim is ... the same ... only the Manner of Offering Is Different." ... In the Mass ... Christ ... is offered in an un-bloody manner" (CCC-1367). 38. When the Church celebrates the Eucharist the Sacrifice Christ offered once for all on the Cross remains ever present ... Celebrated on The Altar, The Work of Our Redemption is Carried Out (CCC-1364). 39. Christ gives us the Very Blood which, He gave ... on the cross, the very blood ... "Poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins" (CCC-1365).

Jesus ... being delivered by the determinate counsel and foreknowledge of God, ye have taken and by wicked hands have crucified and slain: whom God hath raised up, having loosed the pains of death: because it was not possible that He should be holden of it ... He seeing this before spake of the resurrection of Christ, that His soul was not left in hell, neither His flesh did see corruption this Jesus hath God raised up ... we ... are witnesses." Paul: Colossians 2:8 "Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the traditions of men, and not after Christ." Hebrews 9:24-28 "For Christ is not entered into the holy places made with hands, which are the figures of the true: but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us: Nor yet that He should offer Himself often ... For then must He often have suffered since the foundation of the world: but now in the end of the world hath He appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of Himself. And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment: So Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many; and unto them that look for Him, shall He appear the second time without sin unto salvation." Jesus: Matthew 11:25, 28-30 "I thank thee, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes ... I do not frustrate the grace of God: for if righteousness come by the law, then Christ is dead in vain."

JESUS: "I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me" Jn 14:6.

God the Father's Son, the sinless Jesus shed His blood, suffering the penalty of <u>death</u> for all our sin. Jesus was <u>buried</u> and <u>rose</u> in victory, over sin and death. **By believing in Jesus** <u>the hell bound</u> <u>sinner</u> receives forgiveness, Jesus' righteousness, everlasting life and is indwelt by God the Holy Spirit; sealed as God's child and strengthened to love God and others like Jesus. Read God's Word, confess and turn from your sin, {use <u>the keys of heaven</u> to enter}

Put your faith in and give your life to Jesus. Love and good deeds glorify God – they do not help earn our salvation.

40. It <u>Re-Presents</u> ... <u>The Sacrifice of the Cross</u> ... It applies its fruit: [Christ ... wanted] to leave ... the Church a Visible Sacrifice ... Re-Presented ... and ... Applied to the forgiveness of the sins we daily commit (CCC-1366). PARTICIPATION OF LAY PEOPLE IN CHRIST'S PRIESTLY OFFICE. 42. The Eucharist is also the Sacrifice of the Church. The Church which is the Body of Christ participates in the offering of her Head. With Him, she herself is offered whole and entire. She unites herself to His intercession ... In The Eucharist the Sacrifice of Christ becomes also the Sacrifice of the members of His body ... Their praise, sufferings, prayers, and work, are united with those of Christ and with His total offering ... Christ's Sacrifice present on the altar makes it possible for all generations of Christians to be united with His offering (CCC-1368). 45. The Eucharistic Sacrifice is also offered for the faithful departed who "Have died in Christ but are not yet wholly purified" (CCC-1371). PURGATORY 46. All who die in God's grace ... still imperfectly purified, are ... assured of ... eternal Salvation ... after death they undergo purification (CCC-1030). 47. The Church gives the name Purgatory to this (CCC-1031). 48. The Church ... commends almsgiving, indulgences, and works of penance ... on behalf of the dead (CCC-1032). ANOINTING OF **THE SICK 51.** (This) Sacrament ... completes our conformity to death and resurrection of Christ, just as Baptism began it (CCC-1523). CHURCH / MOTHER 55. Salvation comes from God alone ... "We believe the Church as the Mother of our new birth, and not ... the author of our Salvation" (CCC-169). 56. The Church ... guards "The faith ..." Our Mother teaches us the language of faith in order ... to introduce us to the understanding and the life of faith (CCC-171). 57. The Churches message "Is true and solid ... one and the same way of Salvation appears throughout the Whole World" (CCC-174). AUTHENTIC INTERPRETATION 58.
