

HEAVEN

The Revelation of Jesus Christ... Blessed

is he that **reads**, and they that **hear the words** of this prophecy, and keep those things which are **written** therein: for the time is at hand...

Revelation 1:1, 3

21:1. And I saw a **new heaven** and a **new earth**: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was **no more sea**.

2. And I John saw the Holy City, **new Jerusalem**, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

3. And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the **tabernacle of God is with men**, and He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people, and God Himself shall be with them, and be their God.

4. And **God** shall **wipe away all tears** from their eyes; and there shall be **no** more **death**, neither **sorrow**, nor **crying**, neither shall there be any more **pain**: for the former things are passed away.

5. And He that sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make **all things new**. And He said unto me, **Write**: for these words are true and faithful.

6. And He said unto me, **It is done**, I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. **I will give unto him that is athirst** of the fountain **of the water of life freely**.

7. He that overcomes shall inherit all things; and **I will be his God**, and **he shall be My son**.

8. ...

9. And there came unto me one of the seven angels... saying, Come hither, I will show thee **the bride, the Lamb's wife.**

10. And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and showed me **that great city, the holy Jerusalem,** descending **out of heaven from God,**

11. **Having the glory of God:** and her light was like unto a stone most precious, even **like a jasper stone, clear as crystal;**

12. And had **a wall great and high,** and had **twelve gates,** and at the gates twelve angels, and names written thereon, which are the names of the twelve tribes of the children of Israel:

13. On the east three gates; on the north three gates; on the south three gates; and on the west three gates.

14. And the wall of the city had **twelve foundations,** and **in them the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb.**

15. And he that talked with me had a golden reed to measure the city, and the gates thereof, and the wall thereof.

16. And **the city lies foursquare,** and the **length** is as large as the **breadth:** and he measured the city with the reed, **twelve thousand furlongs.** The **length** and the **breadth** and the **height** of it are **equal.**

17. And he measured the **wall** thereof, an **hundred** and **forty** and **four cubits,** according to the measure of a man, that is, of the angel.

18. And the building of the **wall** of it was **of jasper:** and the **city** was **pure gold, like unto clear glass.**

19. And the **foundations** of the wall of the city were **garnished** with all manner **of precious stones.** The first foundation was jasper; the second, sapphire; the third, a chalcedony; the fourth, an emerald;

20. The fifth, sardonyx; the sixth, sardius; the seventh, chrysolite; the eighth, beryl; the ninth, topaz; the tenth, a chrysoprasus; the eleventh, a jacinth; the twelfth, an amethyst.

21. And the **twelve gates** were **twelve pearls;** **every** several **gate** was of **one pearl:** and the **street** of the city was **pure gold, as it were transparent glass.**

22. And I saw no temple therein: for the **Lord God Almighty** and the **Lamb** are **the temple** of it.

23. And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the **glory of God** did **lighten** it, and the **Lamb** is the **light** thereof.

24. And the **nations** of them which are **saved shall walk in the light** of it: and the kings of the earth do bring their glory and honor into it.

25. And the gates of it shall not be shut at all by day: for there shall be **no night there**.

26. And they shall bring the glory and honor of the nations into it.

27. And there shall in **no wise enter** into it **anything that defiles ... but they** which are **written** in the **Lamb's** book of life.

22:1. And he showed me a pure **river of water of life**, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the **throne of God** and of the **Lamb**.

2. In the midst of the street of it, and on either side of the river, was there the **tree of life**, which bare **twelve manner of fruits**, and yielded her fruit **every month**: and the **leaves** of the tree were **for the healing** of the nations.

3. And there shall be **no more curse**: but the **throne of God** and of the **Lamb** shall be **in it**; and **His servants shall serve Him**:

4. And **they shall see His face**; and **His name** shall be **in their foreheads**.

5. And there shall be **no night** there; and they need **no candle**, **neither** light of the **sun**; for the **Lord God** gives them **light**: and they shall reign for ever and ever.

14. Blessed are they that do His commandments, [**And this is His commandment**, That we should **believe on the name of His Son Jesus Christ**, and love one another... **1 John 3:23**] that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.

17. And the Spirit and the bride say, **Come**, And let him that heareth say, **Come**. And let him that is athirst **come**. And **whosoever will**, let him **take the water of life freely**.

20. He which testifieth these things saith, Surely I come quickly.

21. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. A-men'.

God the Father: Luke 15:11. ...A certain man had two sons: 12. And the younger of them said to his father, Father, give me the portion of

goods that falleth to me. And he divided unto them his living (or livelihood). **13.** And not many days after the younger **son** gathered all together, and took his journey into a far country, and there **wasted his substance** (possessions) with riotous (prodigal) living ... **17.** And **when he came to himself**, he said... **18. I will** arise and **go** to my father, **and will say** unto him, **Father, I have sinned** against heaven, and before thee ... **20.** And **he arose, and came** to his father. But when he was yet a great way off, **his father saw him, and had compassion**, and ran, and fell on his neck, and kissed him. **21.** And the **son said** unto him, Father, **I have sinned** against heaven, and in thy sight, and **am no more worthy to be called thy son.** **22.** But **the father said** to his servants, Bring forth the best robe, and put it on him; and put a ring on his hand, and shoes on his feet: **23.** And bring hither the fatted calf, and kill it; and let us eat, and be merry. **24.** For this **my son was dead, and is alive again; he was lost, and is found.** And they began to be merry.

God the Son, Jesus: Revelation 3:20. Behold, **I** stand at the door, and **knock**: if any man **hear My voice**, and **open the door, I will come** in to him, and will sup with him, and he with Me.

Matthew 11:28. Come unto Me, all ye that labor and are heavy laden, and **I will give you rest.** **29. Take My yoke** upon you, and learn of Me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall **find rest unto your souls.** **30.** For My yoke is easy, and my burden is light.

God the Holy Spirit, and the True Church: Revelation 22:17. And the **Spirit and the bride say Come.** And let him that hears say, **Come.** And let him that is athirst **come.** And whosoever will, let him **take the water of life freely.**

Luke 24:44. And **He** (Jesus) **said unto them**, These are the words which I spake unto you, while I was yet with you, that **all things must be fulfilled, which were written** in the law of Moses, and in the prophets, and in the psalms, concerning Me. **45. Then opened He their understanding**, that they might understand **the scriptures,** **46.** And

said unto them, **Thus it is written,** and thus it behoved Christ to suffer, and to rise from the dead the third day. **47. And that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in His name** among all nations, beginning at Jerusalem. **48.** And ye are witnesses of these things.

John 20:21. Then **said Jesus** to them again, **Peace** be unto you: as **My Father** hath **sent Me**, even **so send I you.** **30.** And many other **signs** truly **did Jesus** in the presence of His disciples, which are **not written** in this book: **31.** But **these are written**, that ye might **believe** that **Jesus is the Christ**, the **Son of God**; and that **believing** ye might **have life through His name.**

The Angels and All of Heaven: Luke 15:10. I (Jesus) say unto you, there is **joy** in the presence **of the angels** of God **over one sinner that repents.** **32.** It was right that **we** should **make merry and be glad**, for your **brother** (the prodigal son) **was dead and is alive** again, and **was lost and is found.**

Former Haters and Persecutors of Christians: 1 Timothy 1:13. Although I (Apostle Paul) was **formerly** a **blasphemer**, a **persecutor**, and an **insolent** man; but I **obtained mercy** because I **did it ignorantly in unbelief.** **14.** And the grace of our Lord was exceedingly abundant, with faith and love which are in Christ Jesus. **15.** This is a faithful saying and worthy of all acceptance, that **Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners, of whom I am chief.** **16.** However, for this reason I **obtained mercy, that** in me first **Jesus Christ might show all longsuffering, as a pattern to those who are going to believe on Him for everlasting life.**

Relatives who have died and may have gone to hell (hades). **Luke 16:19.** There was a certain rich man... **20.** And there was a certain beggar named Laz'-a-rus ... **22.** And it came to pass, that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels into Abraham's bosom: the rich man also died, and was buried; **23.** And in hell (hades) he lift up his

eyes, being in torments, and sees Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom. **24.** And he cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame. **25.** But Abraham said, Son ... **26.** Between us and you there is a great gulf fixed ... **27.** Then he **(the rich man) said,** I pray thee therefore, father, that thou would **send him to my father's house:** **28.** For I have **five brethren;** that he may **testify unto them, lest they also come into this place of torment.** **29.** **Abraham saith unto him, They have Moses and the prophets** (God's written word); let them hear them. **30.** And he said, **Nay father Abraham: but if one went unto them from the dead, they will repent.** **31.** And he said unto him, **if they hear not Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded though one rose from the dead.**

Christians who patiently love you, try to convince you, rebuke you, exhort you and teach you that our Savior Jesus came and is coming again. **2 Timothy 4:1.** I charge you therefore before God and the Lord Jesus Christ, who will judge the living and the dead at His appearing and His kingdom: **2.** **Preach the word!** Be ready **in season** and **out of season.** Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teaching. **3.** For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine ... **4.** ... they will turn their ears away from the truth ... **5.** But you be watchful in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry. **8.** ... **there is laid up... the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give ... on that Day ...**
