"The Blessed Mother knows you and understands your sufferings even more than you do. She is full of compassion, love, and hope. She offers a remedy for every problem and hope for every affliction. She is the Mother of God and yours, so beautifully represented by this miraculous Pilgrim statue of Our Lady of Fatima.

"At Fatima, Portugal, in 1917, The Blessed Mother gave a saving message to the world. She gave us the solution for America's moral decline, the coming chastisement, which will end in a glorious era of hope, peace, and the triumph of the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

"She requested that we pray one rosary of five decades every day. 'Pray the rosary every day to obtain peace for the world and the end of the war,' she told the three young shepherds on May 13, 1917. In each of the six apparitions, she insisted on the necessity of the daily rosary. "If you see a friend or family member sinking in vice, turn to our Blessed Mother for help.

"She is truly the *guiding star of the way to Our Lord, Jesus Christ."

Since the Council of Trent the local bishop must bear witness to the validity of Marian Apparitions. (Code of Canon Law 212, 753)

GW—not God the Father as he did for Jesus.

"May 13 is the feast of Our Lady of Fatima.

"She is a powerful intercessor and model, especially in a time where sins of the flesh and sins against humanity dominate the culture.

"Our Lady of Fatima appeared six times to the three shepherd children (Lucia, Jacinta and Francisco) from May 13, 2017 – Oct. 13, 1917.

"Throughout her apparitions, she stressed prayer, fasting and **sacrifice** to obtain peace for the world and the conversion of sinners. She particularly encouraged **daily devotion** to the rosary."

"Here's seven powerful quotes from Our Lady of Fatima's Apparitions:

"1) Our Lady: "Do you wish to offer yourselves to God to endure all the sufferings that He may be pleased to send you, as both an act of **reparation for the sins** with which He is offended and an act of supplication for the conversion of sinners?"

"Lucia: Yes. we do.

"Our Lady: Well then, you will have much to suffer. But the grace of God will be your comfort."

(First Apparition-05/13/1917)

2) "Pray the rosary every day to obtain **peace for the world** and the end of the war."

(First Apparition-05/13/1917)

- **3)** "[Jesus] wishes to establish devotion to my Immaculate Heart in the world. **I promise salvation** to those who embrace it; and these souls will be beloved of God like flowers arranged by me to adorn His throne." (Second Apparition—06/13/1917)
- **4)** "...Pray the Rosary every day in honor of Our Lady of the Rosary, in order to obtain **peace for the world** and the end of the war, for **she alone** can be of any avail." (Third Apparition—07/13/1917
- **5)** "Sacrifice yourselves for sinners and say many times, especially when you make a sacrifice, 'O Jesus, this is for love of Thee, for the conversion of sinners, and in reparation for the sins committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary.'" (Third Apparition–07/13/1917)
- **6)** "Pray, pray much, and sacrifice for sinners, for many souls go to hell because there is no one to sacrifice and pray for them."

(Fourth Apparition–August 19, 1917)

7) "I wish to tell you that I want a chapel built here in my honor. I am the Lady of the Rosary. Continue to pray the rosary every day. The war is going to end, and the soldiers will soon return to their homes."
