There is ONE TRUE GOD: FATHER, SON AND HOLY SPIRIT.

"Then God said, 'Let Us make man in Our image, after Our likeness.'" (Genesis 1:26)

"Thus saith God the LORD, He that created the heavens ... the earth and that which cometh out of it; He that giveth breath ... And spirit to them that walk therein ... 'I am the LORD ... My glory will I not give to another.'" (Isaiah 42: 5, 8)

"The LORD He is God in heaven above, and upon the earth beneath: **there is none else.**" (Deuteronomy 4:39)

"But **Christ** being come an High Priest of good things to come ... by His own **blood** He entered in once into the Holy Place, having obtained eternal redemption for us ... Who through the eternal **Spirit** offered Himself without spot to **God**." (Hebrews 9: 11, 12, 14)

"Jesus ... 'He that hath seen Me hath seen the **Father** ... He shall give you another Comforter, that He may abide with you forever, Even the **Spirit** of truth.'" (John 14:9, 16, 17)

"In the midst of the throne, and round about the throne, were four beasts ... and thy rest not day and night, saying, 'Holy, holy, holy is the Lord God Almighty, which was, and is and is to come.'" (Revelation 4:6, 8)

"Whosoever ... shall break one of these least commandments, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least ... But whosoever shall do and teach them, the same shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven." (Matthew 5:19)

"Whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of breaking all of it." (James 2:10)

"I John saw **the Holy City**, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven ... **there shall in no wise enter into it any thing that defileth,** neither whatsoever worketh abomination, or maketh a lie: but they which are written in the Lamb's book of life." (Revelation 21:2, 27)

GOD REWARDS THOSE WHO SEEK HIM, THE DEVOUT AND THE WICKED.

"Without faith it is impossible to please Him: for he that cometh to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him." (Hebrews 11:6)

"Take no thought for your life, what ye shall eat ... drink ... put on ... your Heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things. But seek ye first the kingdom of God and His righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you." (Matthew 6:25, 32, 33)

"Blessed are the undefiled in the way, who walk in the law of the LORD ... they that keep His testimonies, and that **seek Him with the whole heart**." (Psalm 119:1, 2)

"Seek ye the LORD while He may be found, call ye upon Him while He is near: Let the wicked forsake his way, And the unrighteous man his thoughts: And let him return unto the LORD, and He will have mercy upon him; And to our God, for He will abundantly pardon." (Isaiah 55:6, 7)

"Cornelius ... a devout man, and one that feared God with all his house, which gave much alms to the people, and prayed to God alway. He saw in a vision evidently ... an angel of God ... saying ... 'Thy prayers and thine alms are come up for a memorial before God ... now send men ... for ... Peter' ... Peter said, 'of a truth I perceive that God Is no respector of persons: but in every nation he that feareth Him, and worketh righteousness, is accepted with Him. The word which God sent ... preaching peace by Jesus Christ ... you know ... published throughout all Judea ... how God anointed Jesus

... with the Holy Ghost and with power; who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with Him ... in the land of the Jews, and in Jerusalem; whom they slew and hanged on a tree. Him God raised up the third day, and shewed Him openly ... to us ... after He rose from the dead ... He which was ordained of God to be the Judge of quick and dead. To Him give all the prophets witness, that through His name whosoever believeth in Him shall receive remission of sins." (Acts 10:3-5, 34-36, 39, 40, 42, 43)

GOD WANTS US TO ADMIT THAT WE ARE A SINNER.

"He that covereth his sins shall not prosper: But whoso confesseth and forsaketh them shall have mercy." (Proverbs 28:13)

"The LORD is nigh unto them that are of a broken heart; and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit." (Psalm 34:18)

"But to this man will I look ... poor and of a contrite spirit, and trembleth at My word." (Isaiah 66:2)

"Jews and Gentiles ... are **all under sin**; as it is written, there is none righteous, no, not one ... They are **all gone out of the way** ... every mouth may be stopped, and **all the world may become guilty** ... for **all have sinned and come short** of the glory of God." (Romans 3:9, 10, 12, 19, 23)

"If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us." (1 John 1:8)

"I acknowledged my sin ... mine iniquity have I not hid. I said, I will confess my transgressions unto the LORD; and thou forgavest the iniquity of my sin." (Psalm 32:5)

Jesus: "And He spake this parable unto certain which trusted in themselves that they were righteous, and despised other: 'Two men went up into the temple to pray ... The Pharisee ... prayed ... God, I thank Thee that I am not as other men are, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this publican. I ... I ... I ... And the publican ... would not lift up so much as is eyes unto heaven ... saying, God be merciful to me a sinner." (Luke 18:9-13)

"'As I live,' saith the LORD GOD... 'All souls are mine ... the soul that sinneth, it shall die ... Repent, and turn yourselves from all your transgressions; so iniquity shall not be your ruin. Cast away ... your transgressions ... make you a new heart and a new spirit ... For I have no pleasure in the death of him that dieth ... turn ... and live.'" (Ezekiel 18:3, 4, 30-32)

"And death and hell were cast into **the lake of fire. This is the second death**. And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire." (Revelation 20:14, 15)

"He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil." (1 John 3:8)

"For **the wages of sin is death**; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord." (Romans 6:23)

GOD SENT HIS ONLY BEGOTTEN SON, JESUS, TO PAY OFF OUR SIN DEBT: THROUGH HIS DEATH AND SHED BLOOD ON THE CROSS.

"And you, that were sometimes alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet **now hath He reconciled in the body of His flesh through death,** to present you holy and unblameable and unreproveable in His sight: if ye continue in the faith grounded and settled, and be not moved away from the hope of the gospel." (Colossians 1:21-23)

"Then came the soldiers ... to Jesus, and saw that He was dead already, they break not His legs: but one of the soldiers with a spear pierced His side, and forthwith came there out blood and water." (John 19:32-34)

"And you, being dead in your sins ... He quickened together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses; **blotting out the handwriting of ordinances** that was against us ... and took it out of the way, **nailing it to His cross**." (Colossians 2:13, 14)

"Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God." (Hebrews 12:2)

"For we have not a high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was **in all points tempted** like as we are, **yet without sin**." (Hebrews 4:15)

"But we see **Jesus**, who was made a little lower than the angels **for the suffering of death** crowned with glory and honour; that He, by the grace of God, **should taste death for every man**." (Hebrews 2:9)

"For He hath made Him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in Him." (2 Corinthians 5:21)

"The saying that is written, 'Death Is Swallowed Up in victory ...' The sting of death is sin, and the strength of sin is the law. But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ." (1 Corinthians 15:54, 56, 57)

JESUS AFTER HIS BURIAL, WAS RESURRECTED FROM THE DEAD – VICTORIOUS OVER SIN AND DEATH.

"Now in the place where He was crucified there was ... a new sepulcher ... There laid they Jesus." (John 19:41, 42)

"At evening, being the first day of the week ... where the disciples were assembled ... came Jesus and stood in the midst ... He shewed unto them His hands and His side ... But Thomas ... was not with them when Jesus came ... But he said to them, 'Except I shall see ... I will not believe' ... after eight days ... came Jesus ... saith He to Thomas ... 'be not faithless, but believing.' And Thomas answered ... 'My Lord and my God.' Jesus saith ... 'Blessed are they that have not seen, and yet have believed.'" (John 20:19, 20, 24-29)

"And we declare unto you glad tidings ... the promise ... God hath fulfilled ... He hath raised up Jesus ... He raised Him up from the dead, now no more to return to corruption ... through this man is preached unto you the forgiveness of sins: and by Him all that believe are justified." (Acts 13:32-34, 38, 39)

"God ... now commandeth all men everywhere to repent: because He hath appointed a day, in the which He will judge the world in righteousness by that man whom He hath ordained. He hath given assurance unto all men, in that He whereof hath raised Him from the dead." (Acts 17:30, 31)

"So **Christ** was **once offered to bear** the **sins** of many; and unto them that look for Him **shall** He **appear the second time** without sin **unto salvation**." (Hebrews 9:28)

BECAUSE JESUS FINISHED THE WORK, HE IS NOW THE ONLY WAY, THE ONLY TRUTH AND THE ONLY SOURCE OF SPIRITUAL LIFE.

"Jesus ... said, 'It is finished': And He bowed His head, and gave up the ghost." (John 19:30)

"We are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ **once for all** ... For **by one offering** He hath perfected forever them that are sanctified." (Hebrews 10: 10, 14)

Jesus said: "Come unto Me, all ye that labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls." (Matthew 11:28, 29)

"'Lord ... how can we know the way?' Jesus saith ... 'I am the way, the truth, and the life. No man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.'" (John 14:5, 6)

"But as many as received Him, to them gave He power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on His name." (John 1:12)

BECAUSE JESUS FINISHED THE WORK, GOD NOW PURIFIES THE REPENTANT HEART BY FAITH.

"'What shall we do, that we might work the works of God?' Jesus answered ... them, 'This is **the work of God**, that ye **believe on Him whom He hath sent**." (John 6:28, 29)

"For by grace are ye saved **through faith**; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: not of works, **lest any man should boast**." (Ephesians 2:8, 9)

Paul said: "If any other man thinketh that he hath whereof he might trust in the flesh, I more: circumcised ... of Israel ... a Hebrew of Hebrews ... a Pharisee ... touching the righteousness which is in the law, blameless. But what things were gain to me, those I counted loss for the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus My Lord: for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and do count them but dung, that I may win Christ, and be found in Him. Not having mine own righteousness, which is of the law, but which is through the faith of Christ, the righteousness which is of God by faith." (Philippians 3:4-9)

"For he that is entered into His rest, he also hath ceased from his own works, as God did from His." (Hebrews 4:10)

"Now to him that worketh is the reward not reckoned of grace, but of **debt**. But to him that worketh not, but believeth on Him that justifieth the ungodly, this faith is counted for righteousness." (Romans 4:4, 5)

* King David Prayed for God's Forgiveness, You Can Do the Same. "Have mercy on me, O God, according to thy loving kindness: According unto the multitude of thy tender mercies blot out my transgressions. Wash me thoroughly from mine iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin ... Wash me and I shall be whiter than snow ... Hide thy face from my sins, and blot out all mine iniquities. Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me." (Psalm 51:1, 2, 7, 9, 10)

* God Is Waiting to Hear Your Statement of Faith in Jesus. "The Word Is Nigh Thee ... In Thy Mouth, and ... Heart: that is, the word of faith which, we preach; that if thou shalt confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus, and believe in thine heart that God has raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. For the Scripture saith, Whosoever Believeth On Him Shall Not Be Ashamed. For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek: for the same Lord over all is rich unto all that call upon Him. For Whosoever Shall Call Upon the Name of The LORD Shall Be Saved." (Romans 10:8-13)

* Other Statements of Faith In Jesus.
