Apostle John is now speaking to us About Jesus's second coming As Jesus descends from heaven.

"And I saw heaven opened and behold a WHITE horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he does (th) judge and make war ... And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon WHITE horses, clothed in fine linen, WHITE and clean — And out of his mouth goes (th) a sharp sword, that with it he should smite (kill) the nations ... And he has (th) on his vesture and on his thigh a name written, KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS." (Rev. 19:11, 14–16)

"Come now, and let us reason together, saith The LORD: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as WHITE as SNOW; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool." (Isa. 1:18)

The believer's righteousness is equal to and described as the same as Jesus's.

"I beheld till the thrones were cast down, and the Ancient of days (Jesus) did sit, whose garment was **WHITE** as **SNOW**, and the hair of his head like the **pure wool**: his throne was like the fiery flame, and his wheels as burning fire. A fiery stream issued and came forth from before him: thousand thousands ministered unto him, and ten thousand times ten thousand stood before him: the judgment was set, and the books were opened." (Daniel 7:9-10) "And I saw the dead, small, and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the **book of life**: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works — And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire." (Rev. 20:12, 15)

"He that overcomes (th), the same shall be clothed in **WHITE** raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the **book of life**, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels." (Rev. 3:5)

His countenance was like lightning, and his raiment white as snow.

(Matt. 28:3)

"His raiment became shining, exceeding **WHITE** as snow; so, as no fuller on earth can **WHITE** them."

(Mark 9:3)

JESUS, "Behold, I say unto you, Lift up your eyes, and look on the fields; for they are **WHITE** already to harvest." (John 4:35)

"Lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with **WHITE** robes — And cried with a loud voice, saying, **Salvation to our God** which sits (teth) upon the throne, **and unto the Lamb**. What are these which are arrayed in **WHITE** robes? And whence came they? These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them **WHITE** in the blood of the Lamb." (Rev. 7:9–10, 13–14)

JESUS, "I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning, and the ending, says (ith) the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty." (Rev. 1:8) "And the Spirit and the bride say, COME. And let him that hears (eth) say, COME. And let him that is athirst COME. And whosoever will, let him take the water of life freely." (Rev. 22:17)

"He which testifies (th) these things says (ith),. **SURELY**, **I COME** quickly. Amen...

Even so, **COME**, Lord Jesus." (Rev. 22:20)

Westgerdes, **The Tribulation Period** is the Seven Year Period preceding Jesus's Second Coming. After Jesus's return he will establish his reign upon the earth for a Thousand Years during which Satan shall be chained in the bottomless pit. (Rev. 20:1–2)

Westgerdes, After the Thousand Years Satan will be released and he will gather his followers in the final great battle to defeat Jesus, Jesus will destroy Satan and his followers in this final Victory. This Victory will be followed by Jesus's destruction of the current heavens and earth and the creation of a **NEW EARTH** and a **NEW HEAVEN** in which righteousness will reign. (Rev. 20–22)

Westgerdes, About the RAPTURE, what is it?

It is when Jesus calls up his saints, both dead and alive, to join him in the air. In relation to the Seven Year Tribulation period. There are three views, the rapture will be:

Before — to escape God's wrath* (1 Thess. 4:13–5:11). Middle — When the Anti-Christ sets himself up to be worshiped in the newly rebuilt Jewish Temple. After — at Jesus's 2nd Coming.

About the Millennial views concerning Jesus's thousand-year reign.

"AMILLENNIALISTS see it as a spiritual reign in heaven — we are currently in the millennium. Amillennialism is not new — by the time of Augustine, it had become the dominant view of the Eastern Orthodox Church, the Roman Catholic Church, and many Protestants. And it was the view of the reformers, including Calvin and Luther." —Ed Jarrett,

Westgerdes, this is significant because those, or some, who believe this view are looking for Christ return as the world gets more peaceful and united thus, they may be deceived into accepting a false Christ, and ultimately, the Anti-Christ. (1 Thess. 5:3)

CONCERNING JESUS'S 2ND COMING

"Christ was **once** offered to bear the sins of **many**.

"And unto them that look for him shall he appear the SECOND TIME without sin unto salvation." (Heb. 9:28)

"For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus [GW-died after they believed in and surrendered their life to Jesus] will God bring with him. For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and

remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep. For the **LORD HIMSELF** shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air:

"And so shall we ever be with the Lord. Wherefore **comfort** one another with these words." (1 Thess. 4:14–18)

JESUS: "Let not your heart be troubled: ye **believe** in God, **believe** also in me. In my Father's house are many mansions: [**GW**-Jesus isn't waiting **for us** to prepare the earth for him.]

"If it were not so, I would have told you.

"I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also. And which way (whither) I go ye know, and the way ye know. Thomas says (ith) unto him, Lord, we know not which way (whither) you (thou) go (est); and how can we know the way? Jesus says (ith) unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life:

"No man comes (th) unto the Father, but by me — If ye love me, keep my commandments." (John 14:1–6, 15)

"Who **gave himself** for us, that he might **redeem us** from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works." (*Titus 2:11–14*)

JESUS: "And, behold, I COME QUICKLY.

"And my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work shall be.

"I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning, and the end, the first and the last.

"Blessed are they that do his commandments, that they may have right to the **TREE OF LIFE** and may enter in through the gates into the city." (Rev. 22:12–14)

"His lord said unto him, Well done, you (thou) good faithful servant — enter you (thou) into the JOY of your (thy) lord — The redeemed of the LORD shall return and come with singing unto Zion; and everlasting JOY shall be upon their head — and sorrow and mourning shall flee away."
