God's Symbolic & Permanent Sacrifices for Sin: Symbolic: "To Adam also and to his wife did the Lord GOD make coats of skins and clothed them" (Genesis 3:21). Adam and Eve's fig leaves were not enough to cover their guilt and shame, neither did the Law's sacrifice of an earthly lamb satisfy God's requirement of righteousness. "But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away" (Isaiah 64:6). Permanent: Jesus is the second Adam, the sinless Lamb of God. God has sacrificed His own "Lamb" providing an everlasting clothing for sin. John the Baptist, "Sees Jesus coming to him and says, 'Behold the Lamb of God, which takes away the sin of the world" (John 1:29). The Book of Revelation Describes this Clothing at the Marriage Supper of the Lamb, Rev 19:7 "Let us be glad and rejoice and give honor to him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and his wife has made herself ready. 8 And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints." Isaiah declares "He has clothed me with the garments of salvation, he has covered me with the **robe of righteousness**" (Isa 61:10). For Jesus's death to satisfy God's wrath against sin and to be raised to life in victory, the Lamb of God had to be innocent and his blood shed. Lev 17:10 "And whatsoever man there be of the house of Israel, or of the strangers that sojourn among you, that eats any kind of blood; I will even set my face against that soul that eats blood and will cut him off from among his people. 11 For the life of the flesh is in the blood: and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement for your souls: for it is the blood that makes an atonement for the soul. 12 Therefore I said to the children of Israel, 'No soul of you shall eat blood, neither shall any stranger that sojourns among you eat blood." 14 For it is the life of all flesh; the blood of it is for the life thereof: therefore, I said to the children of Israel, Ye shall eat the blood of no kind of flesh: for the life of all flesh is the blood thereof: whosoever eats it shall be cut off" and Acts 15:7 Peter, "Gentiles — should hear the word of the gospel, and believe. —9 Purifying their hearts by faith." (see also - Acts 20:28), 28 James, "No greater burden than -29 "That ye abstain from meats offered to idols, and from blood,

and from things strangled, and from fornication; from which if ve keep vourselves. ve shall do well." Deut 15:20 "You shall eat it before the LORD your God year by year -23 Only you shall not eat the blood thereof; you shall pour it on the ground as water." Lev 3:17 "It shall be a perpetual statute for your generations throughout all your dwellings, that ye eat neither fat nor blood." Lev 6:30 "And no sin offering, of which **any of the blood** is brought into the tabernacle of the congregation to reconcile with the rest in the holy place, shall be eaten it shall be burnt in the fire." Lev 7:26 "Moreover ve shall eat no manner of blood, whether it be of fowl or of beast, in any of your dwellings." Lev 7:27 "Whatsoever soul it be that eats any kind of blood, even that soul shall be cut off from his people." Deut 12:16 "Only ye shall not eat the blood; ye shall pour it on the earth as water. 23 Only be sure that you eat not the blood: for the blood is the life; and you may not eat the life with the flesh." Heb 9:7 But into the second went the high priest alone once every year, **not without blood,** which he offered for himself, and for the errors of the people: 12 Neither by the **blood** of goats and calves, but **by his (Jesus) own blood** he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us. 13 For if the **blood** of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of a heifer sprinkling the unclean, sanctifies to the purifying of the flesh: 14 How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? This payment is necessary because "by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin" (Rom 5:12), and only by innocent blood can it be remitted "And without shedding of **blood** is no remission" (Heb 9:22). And this happens only through 19 "The **precious blood of Christ**, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot -21 Who by him do believe in God, that ***raised him** up from the dead, and gave him glory; that your faith and hope might be in God. 22 Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit to unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently: 23 Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which lives and abides forever –25 But the word of the Lord endures forever. And this is the word which by the gospel is preached to you" (1 Pet 1:19, 21–23, 25). Jesus, 24 "Because he continues [for]ever. [he] has an unchangeable priesthood, 25 Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come to God by him, seeing he ever lives to make intercession for them. 26 For such a high priest became us, who is holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, [Sinners cannot add anything to Jesus's sacrifice for sin.] and made higher than the heavens; 27 Who needs not daily, as those high priests, to offer up sacrifice, first for his own sins, and then for the people's: for this he did once, when he offered up himself. 28 For the law makes men high priests which have infirmity; but **the word of the oath**, which was since the law, makes the Son, [a High Priest] who is consecrated for evermore." (Heb 7:24-28) The Jewish Priesthood was established by God's Law, Catholic's by Man.

Hebrews 13:8 "Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and today, and forever. 9 Be not carried about with diverse and strange doctrines. For it is a good thing that the

heart be **established with grace**; not with ceremonial *meats*, which have not profited them **[O.T.** Priests] that have been occupied therein. 10 **"We** (Jews) have an altar, from which **they have no right to eat** which serve the tabernacle. 11 For the bodies of those beasts, whose **blood** is brought into the sanctuary by the high priest for sin, are **burned without the camp**. 12 "Wherefore Jesus [N.T. Priest] also, that he might sanctify the people (Jews & Gentiles) with his own <u>blood</u>, suffered without the gate."

[All Christians baptized and anointed by the Holy Spirit have a "Royal Priesthood" (1 Pet 2:9) and an altar from which they have no right to eat.] 13 "Let us go forth therefore to him without the camp, bearing his reproach. 14 For here we have no continuing city, but we seek one [The New Jerusalem, Rev 21:2] to come. 15 By him (Jesus) therefore let us Offer the Sacrifice of Praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips Giving Thanks to his name. 16 But to Do Good and to Share forget not: for with such sacrifices God is well pleased." (Heb 13:8–16) N.T. Priesthood, We Have No Right to Eat. Catholics, "When presented with a direct question about the Real Presence,

(John 6:32-33, 35, 40, 47-51). "He (Jesus) was in the world, and the world was made by him, and the world knew him not. He came to his own, and his own received him not. But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name: Which were born, not of blood, or of the will of the flesh or of the will of man, but of God. And the *Word* [God the Father's spoken word] was made *flesh*, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth." (John 1:10–14)

John 6:53 Jesus, "Truly, truly, I say to you, 'Except ye eat the *flesh* of the Son of *man*, [The word of God, the scriptures: see *John 6:67–69] and drink his blood, ye have no life in you." 54 Whoso eats my *flesh*, and drinks my blood, has eternal life; and I will raise him up at the last day. 55 For my *flesh* is *meat* indeed, and my blood is drink indeed. 56 He that eats my *flesh*, and drinks my blood, dwells in me, and I in him." (John 6:53–56). "But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us, even when we were dead in sins, has *QUICKENED* us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;) And has raised us up together and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus." (Eph 2:4–6) "As the living Father has sent me, and I live by the Father: so he that eats me, even he shall live by me. This is that bread which came down from heaven: not as your fathers did eat manna, and are dead: He that eats of this bread shall live forever —Does this offend you? What and if ye shall see the Son

of man ascend up where he was before? It is the spirit that **OUICKENS**: The flesh profits nothing: the WORDS that I speak to you, they are spirit, and they are life." (John 6:57–58, 61–63) "But the hour comes, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeks such to worship him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth." (John 4:23–24) "Jesus says to them, 'My *meat* is to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work." (John 4:34) Jesus didn't use the metaphor of eating his Father's flesh but he did commit himself to doing his Father's will and finishing his work **preaching** the cross. When Jesus asked his disciples to eat his flesh and drink his blood Jesus wanted them to commit themselves to do his will and to finish his work. Peter understood that when Jesus asked, 'Will ve also go away?' Peter said, 'You have the words of eternal life.' *(John 6:67-69) Apostle Paul: "For so has the Lord commanded us, saying, 'I have set you to be a light to the Gentiles, that you should be for salvation to the ends of the earth." (Acts 13:47) The Christians meat is to preach the cross. "But God forbid that I should Glory, except in the Cross of our Lord Jesus Christ." (Gal 6:14) "But there are some of you that believe not —No man can come to me, except it were given to him of my Father." (John 6:64-65) "But who says ye that I am? And Simon Peter answered and said, 'You are the CHRIST, the Son of the living God." And Jesus answered and said to him, 'Blessed are you, Simon Barjona: For flesh and blood has not revealed it to you, but my Father which is in heaven.' "And I say also to you, 'That you are Peter, and upon this **ROCK** I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.' "And I (Jesus the Christ vs. 21) will give to you the *keys of the kingdom of heaven—how that he must go to Jerusalem and *suffer many things of the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be *killed, and be *raised again the third day." (Matt 16:15-21) [Your response to the gospel will bind or forgive your sins.] "Then said Jesus to the twelve, 'Will ye also go away?' Then Simon Peter answered him, 'Lord, to who shall we go? You have the **WORDS** [Bread] of eternal life. And we believe and are sure that you are that CHRIST, the Son of the living God.' *(John 6:67–69) "When the tempter (Satan) came to him (Jesus), he said, 'If you be the Son of God, command that these stones be made bread. But he answered and said, 'It is written,' 'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every WORD that proceeds out of the mouth of God.'" (Matt 4:3-4: see also Duet 8:3: Luke 4:4)

"Our Father which is in heaven, Holy and Sacred be your name. Your kingdom come, your will be done in earth, as it is in heaven. **Give us this day our DAILY** <u>**BREAD**</u>." (Matt 6:9–11)



"As newborn babes, **desire** the sincere **milk of the WORD**, that ye may **grow** thereby. —Everyone that uses milk is unskillful in the **WORD** of righteousness: for he is a babe. But strong **MEAT** belongs to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to **discern** both **good** and **evil**. —This is **my comfort** in my affliction: for your **WORD** has **QUICKENED me.** —**Faith comes by hearing**, and hearing by **the WORD of God**." (1 Pet 2:2; Heb 5:13–14; Psalm 119:50; Rom 10:17)

"Abel was a keeper of sheep, but Cain was a tiller of the ground. And in [the] process of time, it came to pass, that Cain brought of the fruit of the ground



I'm thinking, this one, God's WORD. (John 6:32-35; Rom 10:17)

an offering to the **LORD**. And **Abel** —brought of the firstlings of his flock and of the fat thereof. And the **LORD** had **respect unto Abel** and to his offering: But to **Cain** and to his offering he **had no respect**." (Gen 4:2–5)

God had respect to **Abel's** offering because **it involved** an innocent death and shed blood. God had no respect to **Cain's** offering because **it did not involve** an innocent death or shed blood. **God** said **Cain** was "very wroth" it seems so wroth that he went out and killed his brother and shed his blood.

Catholics teach that at the sacrifice of the Eucharist during Mass,

"Christ who offered himself once in a **bloody** manner on the altar of the cross is contained and is offered in an **unbloody** manner." (CCC–1367)

Catechism of the Catholic Church

Just as God had no respect for Cains **unbloody** sacrifice, God has no respect for the **unbloody** sacrifice of the Mass / Eucharist. In fact, there is no **blood** shed in any of the Catholic Sacraments or in Purgatory.

When Jesus, "Saw their faith, he said to him, 'Man, your sins are forgiven you." (Luke 5:20) Jesus Christ who once for all, "offered himself in a bloody manner on the altar of the cross," has had this offering respected by God, proven by Jesus's resurrection from the dead. It does not ever need to be reoffered again. Hebrews 9:22 "And almost all things are by the law purged with blood; and without shedding of blood is no remission

[of sin, vs. *26; The **unbloody Mass** cannot pay for sin]. 23 It was therefore necessary that the patterns of things in the heavens should be purified with these; but the heavenly things themselves with better sacrifices than these. 24 For Christ is not entered into the holy places made with hands,

[Catholic Churches, or tabernacles, or Eucharists, are **not** holy places. **Only** an individual sinner who, by faith in Christ, has been washed by the

blood of the innocent Lamb of God can be a temple of God.] "Which are the figures of the true; but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us: 25 Nor yet that he should offer himself often, as the high priest enters into the holy place every year with **blood** of others; *26 For then must he often have suffered since the foundation of the world: But now **once** in the end of the world has, he appeared to **put away sin** by the sacrifice of himself. 27 And as it is appointed to men **once** to die, but after this the judgment: 28 So, Christ was **once** offered to bear the sins of many; and to them that look for him shall he appear the **second time** apart from sin unto salvation." (Heb 9:22–28)

Christ's supposed **"Comings"** in the Eucharist occur daily, over thousands of times, as an offering for sin, and without salvation.

"I Jesus have sent mine angel to testify to you these things in the churches. I am the root and the offspring of David, and the bright and morning star. And the Spirit and the bride say, *Come.* And let him that hears say, *Come.* And let Him that is thirsty *Come.* And *whosoever will*, let him *Take the Water of Life Freely* ... The Grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. Amen." (Rev 22:1–6,14–17, 21)

"And this is (God the Father's) *his commandment,* that, we should *believe on the name of his son Jesus Christ,* and *love one another,* as he gave us commandment. And *he that keeps his commandments dwells in him,* and he in him. And hereby **we know** that he abides in us, by the *Spirit* which he has given us." (1 John 3:23–24)

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Apostle Paul Preaches: Jesus, Faith, and the Spirit.

"And I, brethren, when I came to you, came not with excellency of speech or of wisdom, declaring to you the testimony of God. For I determined not to know anything among you, except Jesus Christ, and him *crucified. "And I was with you in weakness, and in fear, and in much trembling. And my speech and my preaching were not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power: That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the **power of God. Howbeit** we speak wisdom among them that are perfect: **Yet not** the wisdom of this world, or of the princes of this world, that come to nothing: But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world to our glory: *Which none of the princes of this world knew: For had they known it, they would not have *crucified the Lord of glory. But as it is written, Eye has not seen, or ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God has prepared for them that love him. But God has revealed them to us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God. For what man knows the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? Even so the things of God knows no man, but the Spirit of God. Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the **Spirit** which is of God. That we might know the things that are freely given to us by God." (1 Cor. 2:1-12) Paul, "And you have he **QUICKENED**, who were dead in trespasses and sins. Which in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now works in the children of disobedience: Among who also we all had our behaviors in times past in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind; and were by nature the children of wrath, even as others. "But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love with which he loved us, even when we were **Dead** in sins, has **QUICKENED** us together with **Christ**, (by grace ye are **saved**;) **And has** raised us up together and made us **sit together** in heavenly places **in Christ Jesus**:

Today! you can be seated in Christ.

"That in the ages to come he might show the exceeding riches of his grace in his kindness toward us **through** ¹ **Christ Jesus.** For by grace are ve ***saved through** ² ***faith**; and that not of yourselves: it is the *gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast [Salvation is the Gift] -But now in **Christ Jesus** ye who sometimes were far off are made near

*by the blood of Christ.

For he is our peace, who has made both one —And that he might reconcile both (Jew and Gentile) to God in one body

***by the cross,** having slain the enmity thereby: And came and **preached** peace to you (Gentiles) which were afar off, and to them (Jews) that were near. For through him we both have access

*by one Spirit to the Father.

Now therefore, **ye are no more strangers** and foreigners, but fellow citizens (Jew and Gentile) with the saints, and of the household of God; And are built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ himself being the chief corner stone; In who all the building fitly framed together grows to a holy temple in the Lord: In who ye also are built together for a habitation of God

through the ³ Spirit." Through: ¹ Christ Jesus, ² *faith, ³ Spirit. (Eph. 2:1–9, 13–14, 16–22).
